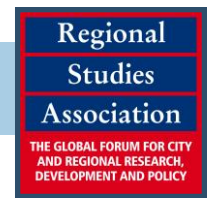

The Regional Studies Association invites researchers, policy makers and practitioners interested in the conference's themes to apply to present their research during a paper presentation or the form of a poster.

Poster presentations are an excellent way for authors to share findings and display their work. The purpose of the poster is to serve as a summary and an advertisement of the work that supplements the presentation. The poster should act as an illustrated version of the abstract visually displaying the data and small blocks of text that explain the project and support the data.

Poster Guidelines

- Poster size is A0 = 16 x A4, landscape or portrait oriented are accepted;
- The poster should make a unified, coherent statement;
- The poster, both textual and visual, should be of professional quality and be clearly readable from a distance of 1 meter;
- The text should be limited to brief statements;
- An abstract for your poster is required for the registration and will be added to the conference handbook.
