### Typology of regional disparity







Туре	Characteristic	Economic theory	Policy instruments
Horizontal disparity	Between different territories; internationally common	Keynesian growth theory Neo-classical growth theory New growth theory	State intervention, redistributive; Free-market, liberalism; Growth oriented, innovation
Urban-Rural disparity	Between core and periphery; common in developing countries	Stage theory	State-led; National development; Urban bias
Vertical disparity	Between administrative hierarchy; Only few countries	Political economy? "growth pole"?	State-led; Mobility control; Social exclusion Urban primacy

















### Per capita GDP of the Four Regions in 1952-2010



#### CVw of Per capita GDP at provincial level in 1952-2010




#### Theil Index in 1952-2010











# Regional Disparity in Henan Province -- Per Capita GDP Cites Iniversity (RMB yuan)



### Regional Disparity in Henan Province -- Annual Net Income (per Capital, University rural households)




### Regional Disparity in Henan Province -- Annual Depositifable Winiversity Income (per capita, urban households)








### Chinese Governmental Structure
