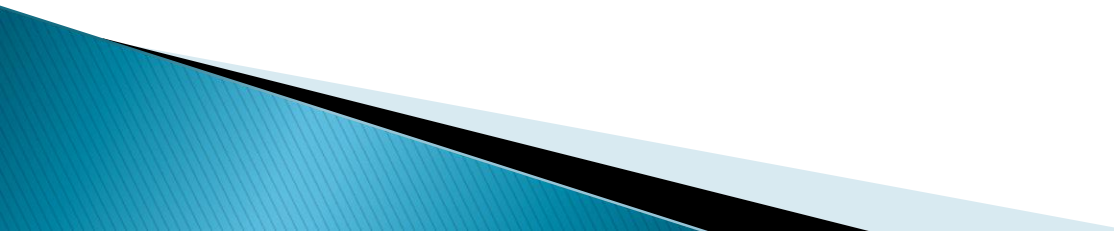

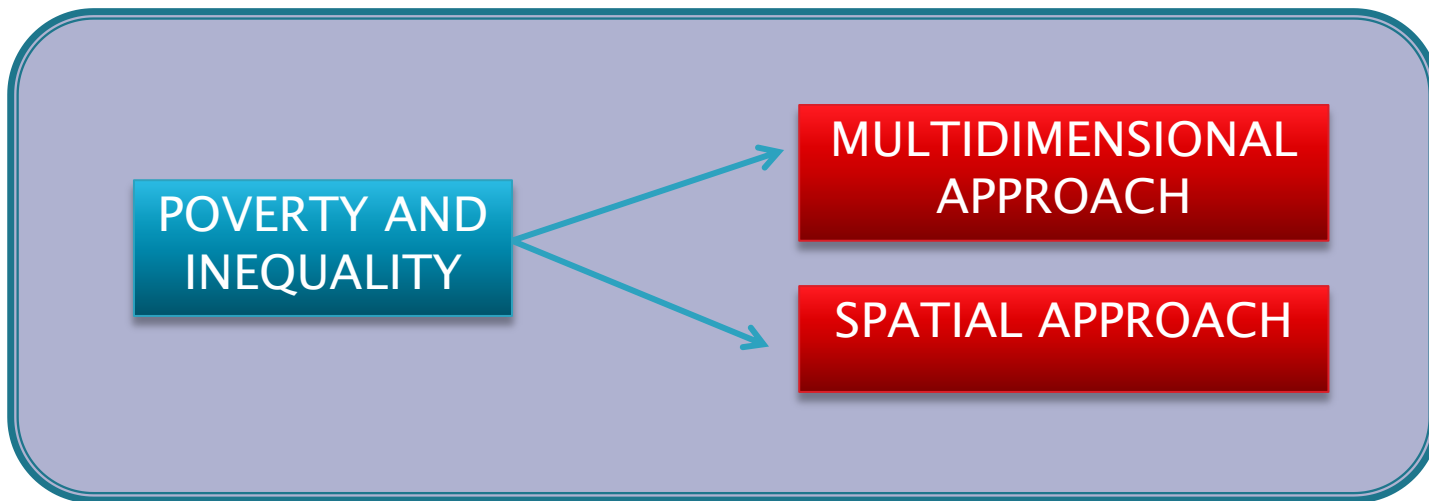

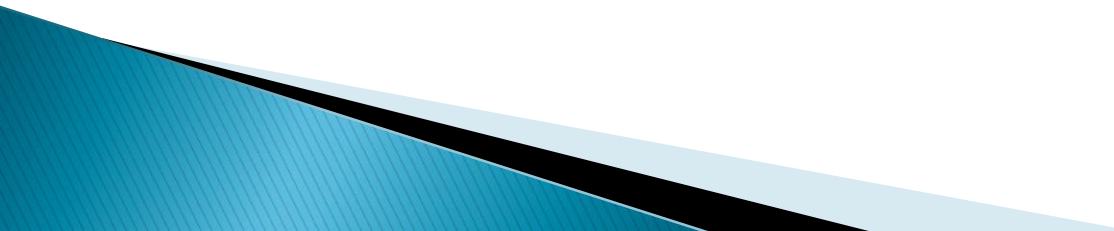

# 1 – Introduction

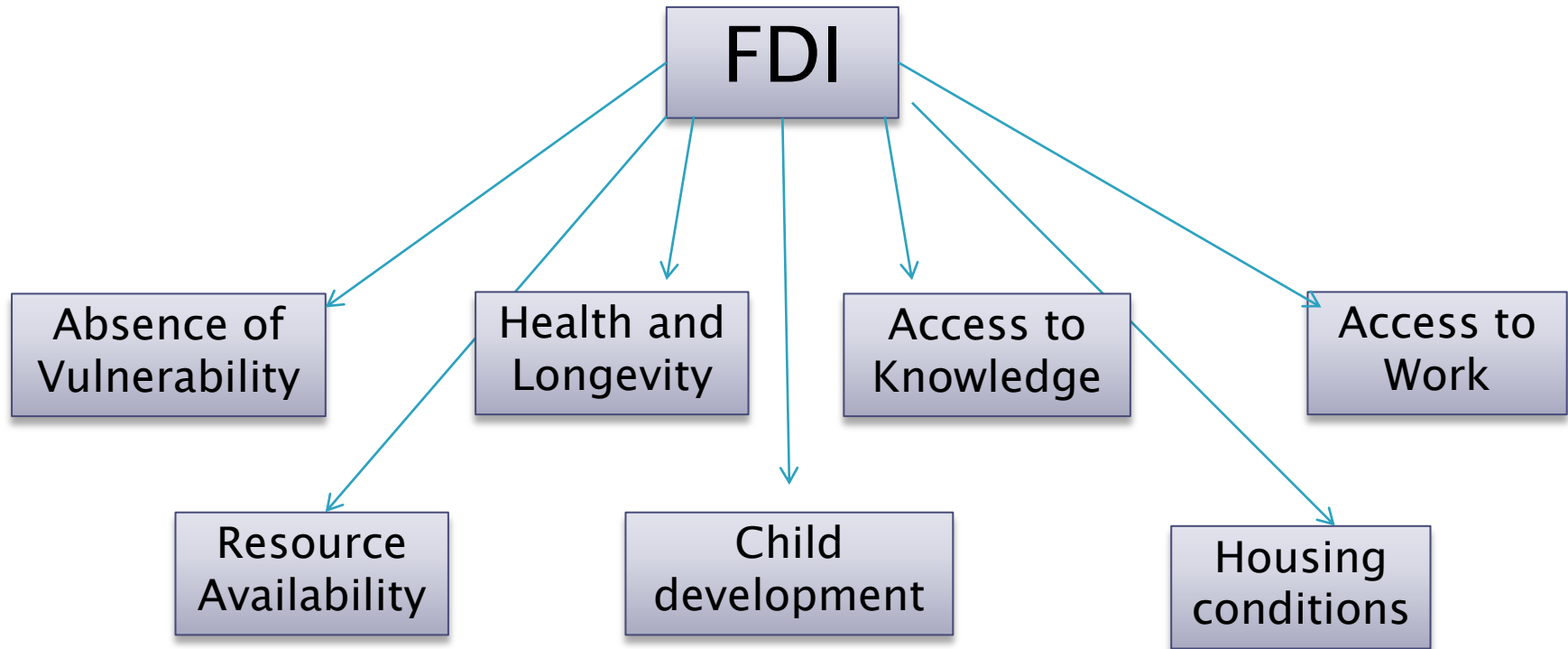
- ▶ One dimensional approach x Multidimensional approach

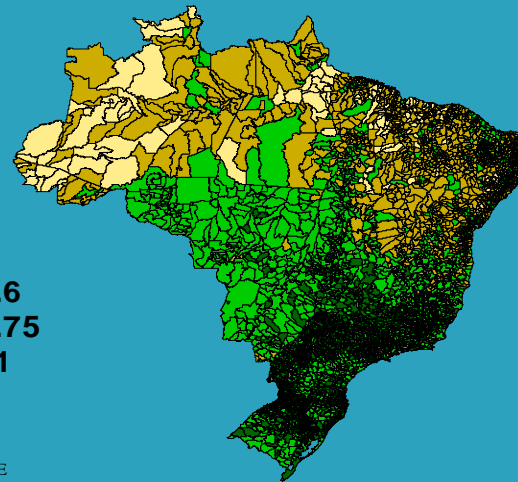
