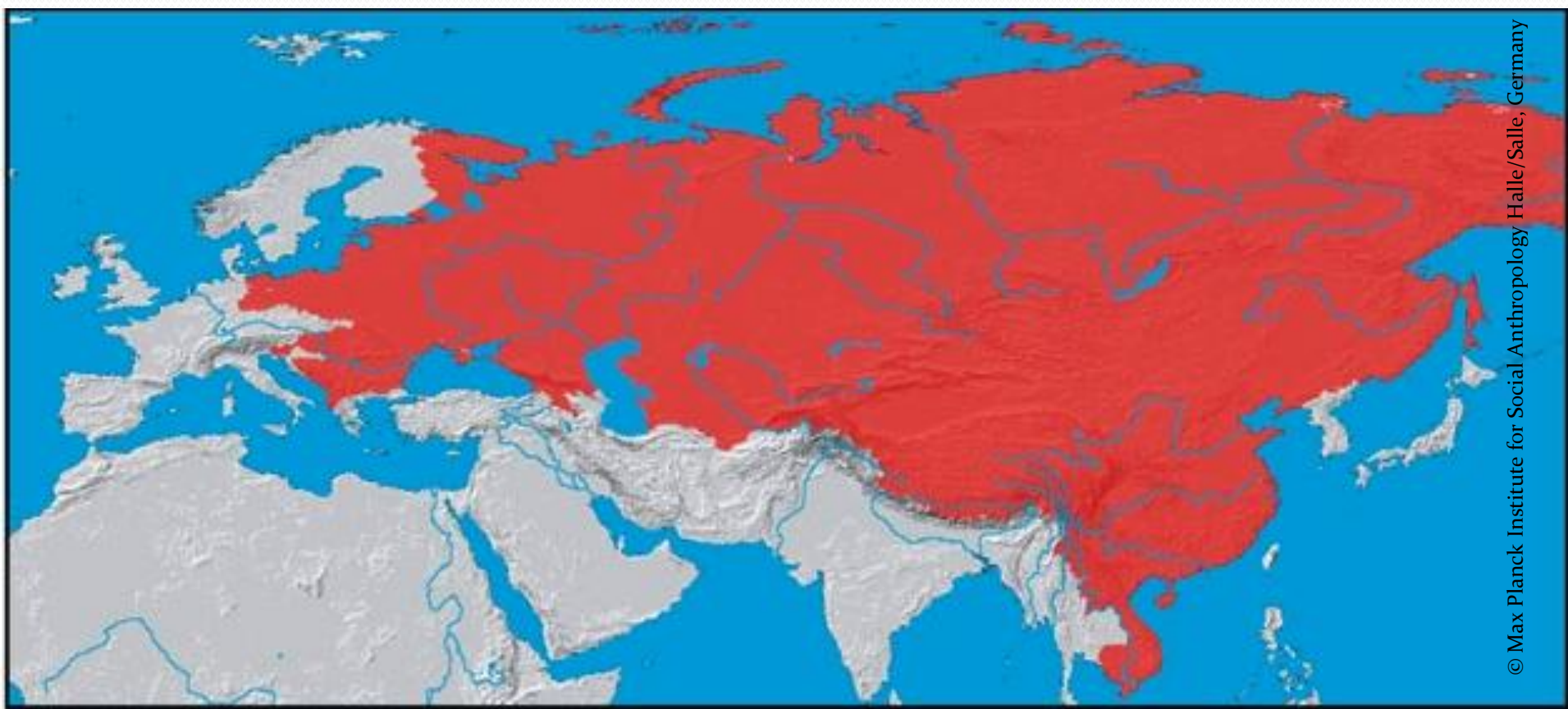

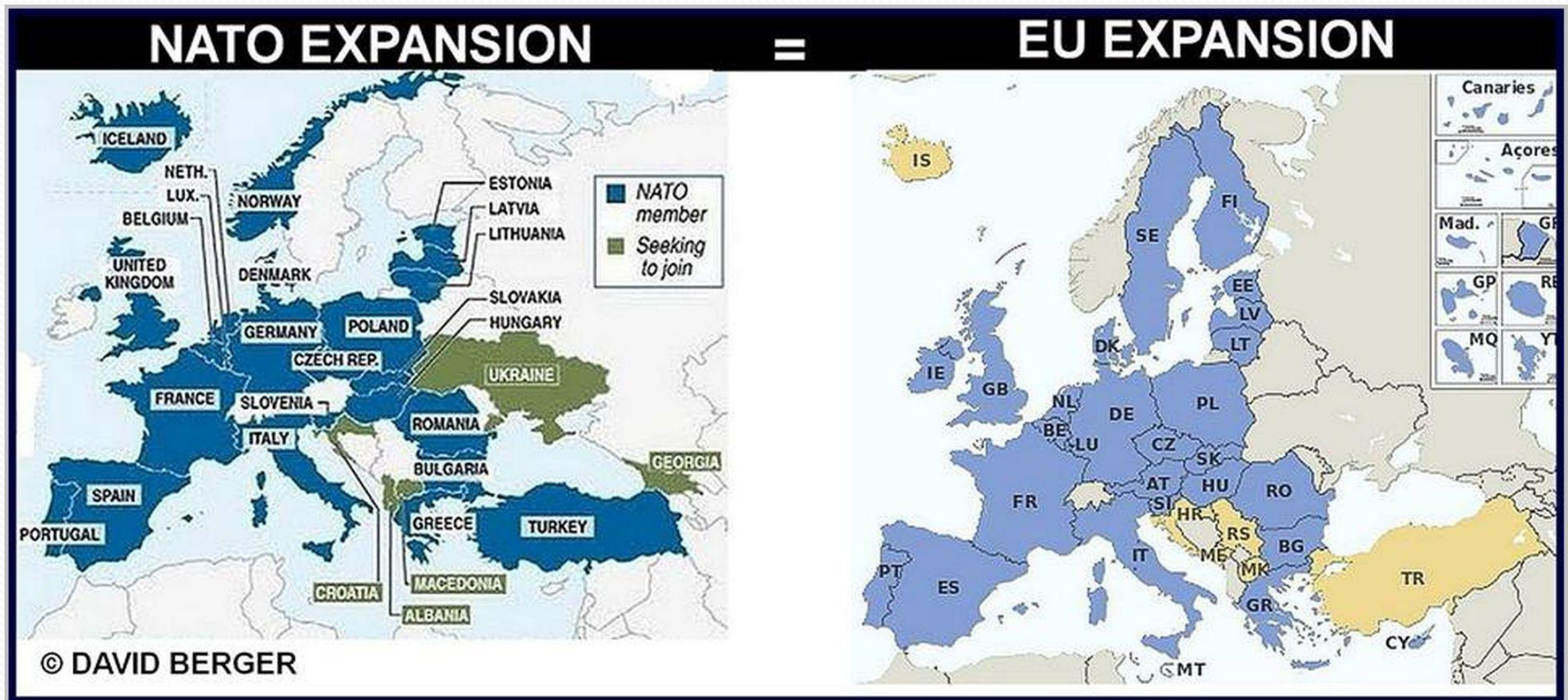


The Objectives of the Eastern Partnership

3. To promote the 'common values' of democracy, respect for human rights and rule of the law
4. To further economic integration
