Conference Terms and Conditions

1. Payment must be made during the registration process. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to those who have not paid.
2. Papers for presentation will NOT be included within the programme unless the conference registration fee has been received in full.
3. The maximum number of abstracts a delegate can submit and present is two abstracts, and this includes parallel paper sessions, as well as open and closed special sessions.
4. If an abstract is rejected by the conference committee, the delegate concerned will receive a full refund of the conference fee paid.
5. Notification of cancellation must be in writing - either by email, fax or letter and received by the Regional Studies Association before 29th September 2022.
6. Cancellations received on or before 29th September 2022 will be refunded 50% of the registration fee paid. Cancellations received after 29th September 2022 will be non-refundable.
7. Non-arrivals will be non-refundable for any reason.
8. Substitute participants will be accepted at any time - a name will be required.
9. Shared places are not permitted.
10. The organisers reserve the right to change the speakers and programme.
11. The organisers accept no responsibility for the views or opinions expressed by speakers, chairpersons or any other person at the event.
12. You must be 18 or over to attend this event, or be accompanied by a legal guardian.
13. The organisers may upload a pdf of speakers' presentations onto their website shortly after the conference, where the presenter has given permission to do so.
14. The Regional Studies Association strongly advises delegates requiring a visa and/or other travel documentation to enter the United Kingdom to make their application in their home countries at least three months before the intended date of travel. Obtaining the correct travel documentation in time is the sole responsibility of the delegate. Where a delegate is unable to attend because of failure to obtain a visa on time, the normal cancellation policy for registration fees will apply.
15. In the unlikely event of conference cancellation by the organisers, conference registration payments will be refunded in full.
