JUNCTURES\_2022 is organized by the Heidelberg Center for Ibero-American Studies (HCIAS) of Heidelberg University in cooperation with the Heidelberg Center Latin America in Santiago de Chile (HCLA), Chile.

The Heidelberg Center for Ibero-American Studies (HCIAS) and the Heidelberg Center Latin America (HCLA) of Heidelberg University invite all master's and Ph.D. students from the social sciences and the humanities, as well as those in the late stages of their bachelor's degrees to participate in the **summer school JUNCTURES\_2022**, which will be held in the city of Heidelberg (Germany) from **July 25<sup>th</sup> to August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2022**.

**JUNCTURES\_2022** considers the Covid-19 pandemic to be a critical juncture, which may have contributed to the strengthening of current polarization dynamics and social and economic inequality, but that may alternatively be visualized as a window of opportunity for political reforms and for social, economic, and ecological transformation processes. **JUNCTURES\_2022** departs from this background and seeks to encourage participants to critically analyze this window of opportunity and its implications for the post-pandemic societies of Europe and Latin-America from different analytic perspectives.

JUNCTURES\_2022 invites applications from interested students from all around the world to participate and contribute to the success of the summer school. **The application deadline is May 27<sup>th</sup>**. Participants residing within the Latin-American region are eligible for an allowance of up to 1.500 Euros to help cover their accommodation and travel expenses. Participation at **JUNCTURES\_2022** is free of any tuition costs.
