- A strong affinity and motivation for doing basic scientific research in an interdisciplinary setting;
- An open mind and the ability to think creatively and out the box;
- Analytical skills and interest in data analysis;
- An interest in academic theory development and abstraction as well as theory application;
- Affinity with quantitative research methods and programs;
- An independent, pro-active working style;
- Motivation to work in a very dynamic team with outside collaborators;

Excellent scientific communication skills (written and verbally) in English.

The appointment includes a stipend and full tuition.
