4. Fees do not include travel, insurance, local transfers or accommodation.
5. Notification of cancellation must be in writing – by email and received by the Regional Studies Association before 19th April 2023.
6. Cancellations received on or before 19th April 2023 will be refunded 50% of the registration fee paid. Cancellations received after 19th April 2023 will be non-refundable.
7. The 2023 Annual Conference is planned to be run as a blended conference (both online and in-person). Delegate(s) who pay for in-person attendance will not be refunded the difference if they later choose to participate online. Delegates booking for virtual attendance may contact the office to pay the extra to attend in person provided that places remain available.
8. Non-arrivals will be non-refundable for any reason.
9. Substitute participants will be accepted at any time – a name will be required.
10. Shared places are not permitted.
11. In the unlikely event of conference cancellation by the Regional Studies Association, conference registration payments will be refunded in full.
12. The organisers do not accept any liability for the cost of any pre-booked travel tickets or other expenses and therefore purchase of appropriate insurance is advised.
13. Please note that membership status will be checked – if you register as an RSA member but are not you will be invoiced for membership at the prevailing rate or the balance between member and non-member rate whichever is the lesser and your paper will not be accepted until the full fees are paid.

The Regional Studies Association strongly advises delegates requiring a visa and/or other travel documentation to enter Slovenia to make their application in their home countries at least three months before the intended date of travel. Obtaining the correct travel documentation in time is the sole responsibility of the delegate. Where a delegate is unable to attend because of failure to obtain a visa on time, the normal cancellation policy for registration fees will apply.
