Pathways to Future Regional Development

The Institute for Economic Research of the Chamber of commerce of Bolzano (WIFO), the Regional Studies Association (RSA), Eurac Research, the Austrian Institute of Economic Research (WIFO), and the research network on Smart Policies for Regional Innovation, Sustainability and Transitions (SPRiNT) are pleased to announce a two-day workshop on Pathways to Future Regional Development on June 11-12, 2026, focusing on the themes of regional development, innovation, sustainability, and inequality.
